The appointed faculty member will be part of the [Program in International Education](#), which prepares students for professional careers in multinational and international settings. The Program develops educational experts at the MA level who design, implement and manage international education programs, and academics and researchers at the doctoral level who conduct cross-national and evaluation studies of international cultural and educational exchange, student and faculty mobility, education for international development, education in areas of conflict, trans-national migration, multicultural education, and the globalization of higher education. The appointment begins September 1, 2014.

**Qualifications:** Candidates must have an earned doctorate in international/comparative education, or one of the social sciences, including anthropology, sociology, political science, public policy, or comparative history. Field of specialization is open; we seek candidates who use qualitative and/or mixed-methods to study education and international development. The successful candidate should have a well-defined research agenda, an extensive record of published peer-reviewed research, and a demonstrated record of externally-funded research grants.

**Responsibilities:** Research, teaching, development of an externally-funded research program, doctoral and junior faculty mentoring, program administration, and participation in faculty meetings, committees and other service appropriate to a university faculty member is expected.
